Title of the Practice:

“Swachh Bharat Abhiyan – Cleanliness drive by college.”

Objectives of the Practice:

Swachh Bharat Abhiyan is one of the most significant cleanliness campaigns by Government of India. The college gave special focus to this Swachata Abhiyan and conducted various activities throughout the year.

The objectives of this practice are:

- To spread awareness among people about the importance of cleanliness.

The college also joined hands with Gram Panchayat, Sarpanch and different agencies to participate in many cleanliness drives to achieve the objective of this practice.

The Practice:

The college has always insisted on instilling values amongst its students and also in making them aware of their social and moral responsibilities. The college aims to make their students a responsible citizen of the nation by exposing them to various social service camps and drives. With a view to develop a sense of social responsibility the college has established various associations and activities. Under these associations the college joins hands with gram panchayat, sarpanch different agencies to conduct activities and cleanliness drives.

A duly constituted committee of teachers of the college with the help of students conduct different activities and cleanliness drives throughout the year. Drawing inspiration from the

institution's Mission, inculcating values amongst the students have always been given attention and priority.

The students are informed through notices circulated in the class rooms and information is also passed through the college website for the sake of its alumni at regular intervals.

3. Title of the practice: “Opportunities in the time of Pandemic”
